Individual/Family

\$100 As well as the above, as desired, your name, membership and contact information will be listed in our newsletter the volume after you join. This membership is generally for professionals.

Corporate Membership

\$500 As well as the two membership levels above, your corporation will be listed on all workshop and conference agendas.

Informal Affiliate Organization Membership

\$100/year

Your organization will receive the same benefits as the Individual/Family and "Friends" membership. In addition, you will be provided with 1/4 page in each newsletter to announce meetings, events, etc. Your group will receive 25 copies of the newsletter for your use. Your group will also be provided with a website link and listserv address.

Formal Affiliate Organization Membership

\$200 in year your membership is approved.

\$100 in each successive year.
